

## Final pedestrian overlooks set to be poured next week

**Bismarck** – Crews are stripping forms from pedestrian overlooks at piers 7 and 8 to move them to piers 10 and 11 of Memorial Bridge. Once the moves are completed and the overlooks are poured crews will continue to strip forms. The overhang brackets are beginning to come down, giving boaters and other viewers a good idea of the contour and shape of Memorial Bridge.

The subcontractor Rainbow Inc. from Minneapolis, MN is at the job site to begin applying the final surface finish on the exposed surfaces of the bridge and to the retaining wall panels.

Other work planned for the week of June 23-27:

- Setting poles for the bridge lighting.
- Installing traffic and pedestrian railing on the bridge.
- Constructing Modular Block walls.
- Installing conduit and utility lines inside the bridge.
- Continuing work on west plaza.
- Starting the sidewalks on the east side approach below the retaining wall
- Removing construction material and debris from inside the girder.
- Work on intersections on both ends of the bridge.
