Concrete pours initiate spring work on Memorial Bridge Heavy concrete truck traffic expected Friday morning on west end of bridge

Bismarck – Concrete crews will pour the top concrete slab on the west transition pier early Friday morning. Next week, crews will pour the west approach to Memorial Bridge. Morning commuters will see more concrete trucks between the Strata concrete plant on Memorial Highway in Mandan and the west end of the bridge during the two pours. It's expected the concrete truck traffic will cause little if any impact on the morning commute.

Pouring the west approach and top transition pier at Memorial Bridge are two of the preliminary steps ahead of the bridge deck pour later this spring. Machinery and equipment is being assembled at the site for the bridge deck pour which could start the week of April 12. Crews are now tying the reinforcement steel for the deck.
