Crews strip forms and move equipment from Memorial Bridge project Concrete placed for overlooks and median barriers

Bismarck – Crews with Lunda Construction continue moving out equipment that is no longer needed such as cranes while demobilizing from the first phase of the Memorial Bridge project. Other work crews finished placing concrete for the north edge barrier and now are working on the south edge barrier. Next week, they plan to place concrete for the median barrier between the lanes. After that, railing and other detail items will be installed.

Two more pedestrian overlooks are expected to be poured next week. Other work planned for the week of June 16-20:

- Continuing work on west plaza.
- Removing construction material and debris from inside the girder.
- Sandblasting and painting.
- Utility placement.
- Work on intersections on both ends of the bridge.
